A Brief History of the Organisation

A graduate of Hosei University, BA (Economics), Mr. Kenichi Ikeno was given management training, May 1971 – September, by SIS (Sveriges Internationella Sommarskolar Ltd, Gothenburg) in UK, Sweden, and Germany.

September 1971 Mr. Kenichi Ikeno founded UTS Centre for International Education (UTS Ltd. Japan) of which he remains the owner and chairman

March 1974 Mr Ikeno founded the College of International Education, Oxford. (CIE-Oxford).

December 1977 – June 1999 UTS became the secretariat of the Anglo-Japanese University Exchange Committee. AJUEC comprises 18 university faculty members.

October 1998 JCSOS (Japanese Council for the Safety of Overseas Students) was founded and UTS is the partner organisation. JCSOS has members from 163 universities (October 2020).

From its beginnings as a language travel organization UTS has developed during nearly 50 years into a consultancy and security support organization for Japanese universities who intend to introduce university exchange or study abroad programmes.
